SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY:

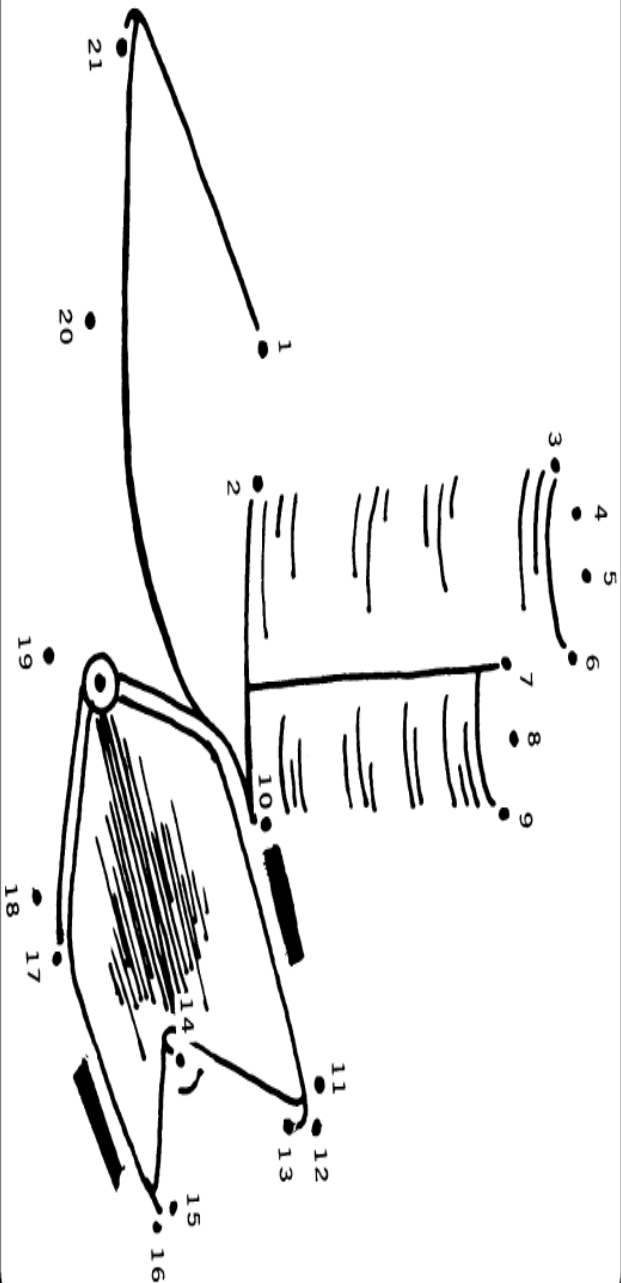
Call Sr. Regina at the Parish Office and make arrangements at least six months in advance. Marriage instructions are required.
